## Membership Fees

### Shipowners

New members benefit from discounts in the first two years of membership of 50% and 25% respectively (subject to minimum fee).

Fees for shipowners and operators that are UK registered companies or commercially and technically manage fleet in the UK are charged on a tonnage basis as outlined below.

Shipowners/operators that have a UK base but own and manage their ships elsewhere are classed as overseas members and are charged a flat fee of £16,500.

Tonnage basis fee per vessel is calculated as follows:

Vessel Type	£/GT
Passengers	0.40
Containers & Freight RORO	0.30
OSV	0.40
Product/oil/gas tankers	0.30
Bulk Carrier (Short Sea)	0.25
Bulk Carrier (Deep Sea)	0.15

The following caps apply:

- 20,000 GT cap on the tonnage of any single vessel.
- Minimum shipowning fee of £2,000
- Maximum shipowning fee of £99,000

### **Professional Members**
